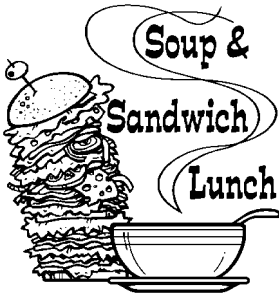

Did you realize that the pro-life Rose Day Rally was started by 2 Catholic women who were moved to action when abortion was legalized in the US? For many years, pro-life Oklahomans gathered on the steps of the State Capitol on the Sundays for Sanctity of the Life rallies. Though the rallies attracted attention from the public and the news media, it seemed that they never impacted legislation. In 1992 Rose Day was established to give participants the opportunity to impact legislation by visiting their Senator, Representation & the Governor in the respective offices, presenting them with a red rose and encouraging them to protect the life of the unborn.

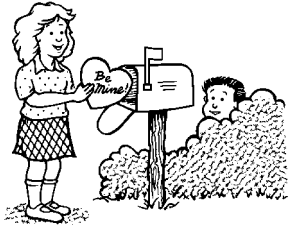

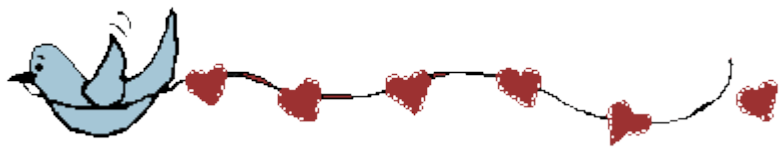

## **Abuse of Minors Pastoral Response Hotline 405-720-9878**

For the safety of children and the healing of victims, the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City provides an Abuse of Minors Pastoral Response Hotline for reporting the abuse of a minor (in the past or presently) by a member of the clergy or other church personnel. Calls to this number will be answered by the Archdiocesan Assistance coordinator who will offer to meet with the caller in person, if the caller so desires. The Assistance Coordinator will also assist you in making a formal complaint to the Archdiocese, arranging a personal meeting with the Archbishop or his representative and in obtaining support and pastoral counseling.



Calls are confidential with the following exceptions:

- \* Any allegation of sexual or physical abuse or neglect concerning those who currently are minors must be reported to the Oklahoma Dept. of Human Services 1-800-522-3511 as required by Oklahoma laws and Archdiocesan policies.

- \* Any allegation of sexual misconduct must be shared with the proper Archdiocesan authorities.

- \* Local law enforcement agencies may also be contacted.

In addition, there are several things you may do:

- \* Contact the Oklahoma Dept. of Human Services 1-800-522-3511. Contacting DHS is mandatory if the victim is a minor.

- \* Contact the appropriate law enforcement agency (for example the local police).

- \* Contact local child protection agencies, a private attorney, &/or a support group.
